

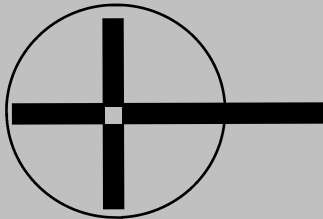

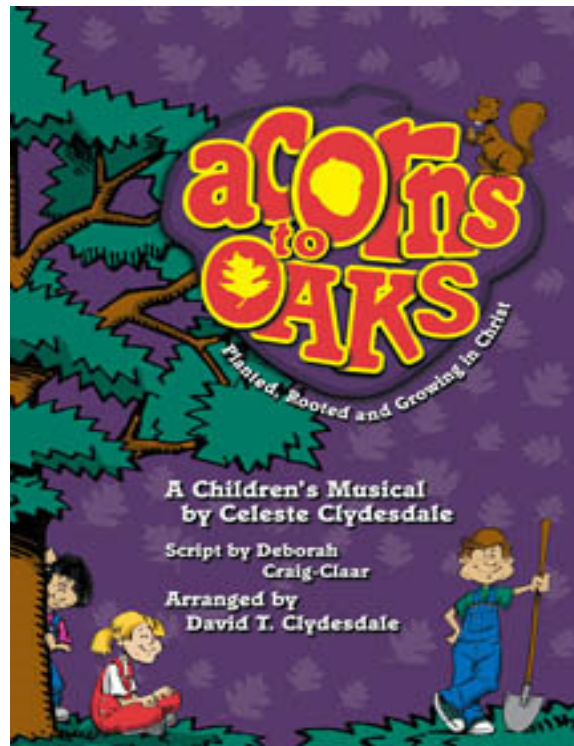

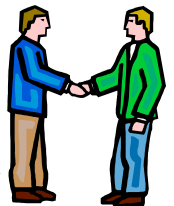

Gymnasium Use Policy

Beginning May 1 there will be a cost of \$25.00 per hour to use the gymnasium for non-church sponsored events such as birthday parties, family reunions, etc. There will be a two-hour minimum charge (\$50.00). This has become necessary as we receive an increasing number of requests for these type events. Custodians have to come after such events to reset basketball goals and set up for Sunday School. It is not fair to ask staff to come on weekends to do this work without pay. This cost does **not** apply to any church-related event such as Sunday School class fellowships. **All** requests to use the gym must be submitted on a request form one week before the event.
