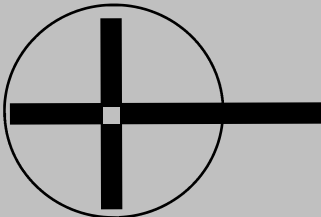

Thank you so much to those of you who helped with the More Than Music Ministry tent at Bonnaroo this week. Of the more than 200 people who worked in this ministry, a large number were from First Baptist. Individuals from our church organized the shuttles for volunteers, drove all the vans, led the Sunday morning worship service, kept all the generators running, organized the free haircuts, set up the tent, and helped with countless other projects. Whenever I was in the tent this week, there was always at least one First Baptist member working in the serving line. We were overwhelmed with the response to this ministry. We ran out of food and repurchased at least three times during the festival. We gave away 100 cases of bananas, 30 cases of oranges, 20 cases of apples, truckloads of snacks, 600 Frisbees, thousands of cups of water, and cases of New Testaments. We used over 250 pounds of sugar just to make sweet tea! Many guests asked, "Why are you doing this?" That gave us an opportunity to tell about the love of Jesus that compels us. Pray for seeds that were planted in the lives of people this week.
